

FLY AMERICA/OPEN SKIES

Decision Tree

Flying from the USA to a foreign country on federal funds

YES

Are you traveling to a foreign country funded by DOD/military departments (Army, Navy, etc.)?

YES

You are not permitted to take advantage of the Open Skies agreements. You must fly on a U.S. flag airline unless you qualify for an exemption as noted in the Fly America Act.

NO

Are you traveling to an EU country/ECAA?

YES

You may fly on a U.S. flag airline or EU airline.

NO

Are you traveling to Australia, Switzerland, or Japan?

YES

Does the government have a published city pairs airfare rate for your travel route?

If yes, you must fly a U.S. flag airline. If no, you may use a U.S. flag airline or an Australian, Swiss, or Japanese airline, respectively.

NO

Traveling to other foreign countries?

YES

You must fly on a U.S. flag airline unless you qualify for an exemption as noted in the Fly America Act.
